

ORDINANCE NO. 31-24

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT APPROPRIATIONS
ORDINANCE NO. 120-23 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, certain funds within the amount appropriated in Ordinance No. 120-23 do not meet the estimated operational expenses; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 120-23 be amended, supplemented and reappropriated as indicated on the attached Exhibit, which is made a part of this Ordinance by reference.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity and desirability of establishing a provision of funds for the expenditures for the fiscal year 2024 in order to maintain an efficient City operation; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor.

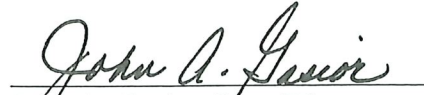

Increase City Hall budget by \$100,000 for Repair/Maintenance of the City of Avon Storage Garage as this was not included in the original budget.

Increase Law Department by \$28,500 for Wages and Benefits of the Victim Advocate as the position was not included in the Original Budget.

Increase Tree Commission budget by \$7,450.00 for Wages and Benefits as this was not included in the original budget.

Increase the Building department by \$50,000 for Plan Reviews as the original budget is insufficient for the remainder of the year.
