

ORDINANCE NO. 39-25

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH PUBLIC CONSULTING GROUP, LLC FOR THE PURPOSE OF COLLECTING SUPPLEMENTAL MEDICAID PAYMENTS FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE AVON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) allows states to establish alternative payment methodologies for certain classes of providers, including ambulance providers; and

WHEREAS, Public Consulting Group, LLC (“PCG”) possesses professional skills that can assist the City to secure Medicaid supplemental payments for qualifying ambulance transports through the Ambulance Supplemental Payment Program (ASPP); and

WHEREAS, the City desires to contract with PCG, an independent contractor, to perform professional services in connection with the Ambulance Supplemental Payment Program (ASPP) as set forth in the attached Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Council, having reviewed the contract with PCG, finds it to be fair and equitable and authorizes the Mayor or his designee, on behalf of the City of Avon, to enter into said contract and doing so will be in the best interests of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Avon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Mayor, or his designee, behalf of the City of Avon, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with PCG in substantially the form as set forth in the attached [Exhibit A](#), which is incorporated herein by this reference, to secure Medicaid supplemental payments for qualifying ambulance transports.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to contract with Public Consulting Group, LLC to secure Medicaid supplemental payments for qualifying ambulance transports before the May 8th deadline; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
