

RESOLUTION NO. R-6-26

**A RESOLUTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE
2026 PAVEMENT MARKING PROGRAM
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, due primarily to normal wear, it is necessary to re-apply various traffic control lane/pavement markings throughout the community during the current construction season; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the Community that the administration go forward with advertising for bids to complete the 2026 Pavement Marking Program based on plans and specifications prepared by the City Engineer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the re-application of pavement markings throughout the community as determined by the City Engineer. These improvements shall be made pursuant to plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer and Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd. which shall be on file and open for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of Council and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4- That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to advertise for bids for the 2026 City of Avon Pavement Marking Program in order to facilitate substantial completion prior to the end of construction season; therefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
