

ORDINANCE NO. 61-26

**AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD THE PUBLIC BID FOR THE
2026 AVON PAVEMENT MARKING PROGRAM
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, due primarily to normal wear and tear, as well as increased traffic, it is necessary for the city to re-apply pavement markings on certain roads/streets within the municipality during the 2026 construction season; and

WHEREAS, Avon City Council, passed Resolution No. R-6-26, on April 13, 2026, which authorized the Administration to solicit public bids for said project known as the 2026 Avon Pavement Marking Program; and

WHEREAS, City officials have determined that the pavement markings on public roadways throughout the city will be re-applied, except where recent project pavement marking installations are still in good condition, pursuant to plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer and Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd. which shall be on file open for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of Council and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the public bids were opened and read aloud at noon on April 30, 2026, at Avon City Hall. The bids received for the 2026 Avon Pavement Marking Program are as follows:

Company	Bid
Aero-Mark Company LLC	\$241,871.17

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Estimate for the project was \$244,343.15 and the lone bid was approximately 1% below that amount. A copy of the bid tabulation and recommendation memorandum is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed the bid submitted and is recommending that Aero-Mark Company LLC be considered an acceptable bid for the 2026 Avon Pavement Marking Program; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the Community that the City Administration go forward with the awarding of a pavement marking contract to Aero-Mark Company LLC for the 2026 Avon Pavement Marking Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That pursuant to bid received on April 30, 2026, at Avon City Hall for the 2026 Avon Pavement Marking Program, the bid submitted by Aero-Mark Company LLC in the amount of Two Hundred Forty-One Thousand, Eight Hundred Seventy-One Dollars and Seventeen Cents (\$241,871.17) is declared to be the lowest and best bid. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with that entity. The Finance Director is hereby

authorized to make payment from the Street Construction Maintenance & Repair Fund No. 201 in the amount set forth herein. In addition, the Finance Director is authorized to increase this appropriation by a reasonable amount for engineering and legal fees associated with the project.

Section 2- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3- That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to undertake and substantially complete the 2026 Avon Pavement Marking Program prior to the end of the 2026 construction season; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.

Please find enclosed a Bid Tabulation for the bid received on April 30, 2026, for the 2026 Pavement Marking Program. A total of One (1) bid was submitted and opened at the City of Avon – City Hall.

The Engineers Estimate for the project was \$244,343.15. The low bid of \$241,871.17 as received from Aero-Mark Company LLC is approximately 1.0% below the Engineers Estimate for the project.
