

RESOLUTION NO. R-11-26

**A RESOLUTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE
MILLS ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, to address pavement maintenance conditions and to maintain safe travel conditions it is necessary to repair and repave Mills Road in its entirety from the Stoney Ridge Road Peanut Roundabout to the Westlake Municipal Boundary as a joint project between the City of North Ridgeville and the City of Avon during the 2026 construction season; and

WHEREAS, the Mayors of the City of Avon and the City of North Ridgeville have spoken and have proposed that the City of Avon serve in the role as the lead agent for the project; and

WHEREAS, a project cooperation agreement has been drafted to memorialize the City of Avon serving as lead agent for the project and said agreement is being considered by the City Councils of both communities; and

WHEREAS, the Avon City Engineer has identified a Mills Road Resurfacing Project which shall include the following: resurfacing without widening of the noted Mills Road section; asphalt pavement planing; asphalt resurfacing with a 3-inch asphalt pavement; partial & full depth pavement repairs; utility adjustments; curb ramp replacements; pavement striping; and appurtenances thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Avon City Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of both communities that the City of Avon goes forward with advertising for public bids for the Mills Road Resurfacing Project to substantially complete the project during the 2026 construction season.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for public bids for the completion of the work items which shall include resurfacing without widening of Mills Road in its entirety from the Stoney Ridge Road Peanut Roundabout to the Westlake Municipal Boundary; asphalt pavement planing; asphalt resurfacing with a 3-inch asphalt pavement; partial & full depth pavement repairs; utility adjustments; curb ramp replacements; pavement striping; and appurtenances thereto at locations determined by the City Engineer. These improvements shall be made pursuant to plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer and Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd., which shall be on file and open for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of Council and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and

any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4- That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon and the City of North Ridgeville, the immediate emergency being the necessity to advertise for bids for the Mills Road Resurfacing Project in order to facilitate substantial completion of the project prior to the end of 2026 construction season; therefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
