

ORDINANCE NO. 57-15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE YMCA OF GREATER CLEVELAND (YMCA) TO PERFORM SERVICES FOR THE CITY'S OUTDOOR AQUATIC FACILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Avon has moved forward with the development of an outdoor aquatic center located on Detroit Road; and

WHEREAS, the Administration desires to enlist the services of the YMCA to assist in the development of safe and enjoyable swimming programs; and

WHEREAS, the City further desires that the YMCA assist in the training and staffing of City employees at the facility to assure all users of the pool that safety is the City's top priority in all facets of the pool's operations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the YMCA. in substantially the form as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, for the development of safe and enjoyable swimming programs and to assist in the training and staffing of employees at the facility. Said Exhibit A, in its final form is incorporated herein and made a part of this ordinance.

Section 2 - Payment for said services to be provided under the terms of the contract shall be made from the Aquatic Center Operating Fund No. 255 per directives of the Finance Director. Council authorizes the Finance Director to expend funds in amounts needed to meet the obligations incurred under the terms thereof.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to enter into a contract with the YMCA to perform services for the outdoor aquatic facility located on Detroit Road; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
