

ORDINANCE NO. 83-14

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 1473 OF THE CODIFIED
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Chapter 1473 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Avon, entitled “Signs” has been amended and/or re-adopted in substantially its same form in Chapter 1290 of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, to eliminate redundancy and confusion the Administration has recommended that Chapter 1473 be repealed; and

WHEREAS, Council, after considering the recommendation of the Administration, finds that repeal of Chapter 1473 is reasonable and necessary to eliminate duplication of provisions that are found in Chapter 1290, and removing said duplication is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That the entire Chapter 1473 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Avon entitled, “Signs”, shall, and the same is hereby, repealed.

Section 2 - The codifier is hereby instructed to remove Chapter 1473 from the Codified Ordinances and insert a notation similar to that which is set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity of repealing Chapter 1473 of the Codified Ordinances to eliminate duplication with Chapter 1290; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
