

ORDINANCE NO. 136-14

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE RETIREMENT
AND CONFIRMING THE RE-APPOINTMENT OF MARTIN R. SUSAK
AS BUILDING INSPECTOR FOR THE CITY OF AVON
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Martin Susak has served in the City of Avon Building Department for more than fifteen years as a Building Inspector; and

WHEREAS, Martin Susak is eligible to retire under the Ohio Public Employment Retirement System (OPERS) but has indicated his willingness to continue to serve the City of Avon in his current capacity without additional cost to the City for the purpose of training subordinates to assume his position at some point in the future; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor recommends, and Council as a whole concurs, in the rehiring of Martin Susak recognizing that such rehire would greatly promote the health, safety and welfare of all residents and businesses located in Avon in that the Administration will be able to maintain his expertise and over fifteen years of knowledge of the City's Building Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Mayor hereby accepts the resignation of Martin Susak for the purpose of retirement through the Ohio Public Employment Retirement System (OPERS) and Council hereby confirms the reappointment of Martin Susak as Building Inspector the day following said day of retirement without loss of current employment benefits.

Section 2 - That the City retirement benefits due Martin Susak shall be deferred until he leaves the employment of the City. The effective date of retirement will be determined by the Ohio Public Employment Retirement System (OPERS), which is estimated to be November 30, 2014.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to enable the Administration to maintain the services and expertise of Martin Susak as a City Building Inspector along with his fifteen-plus years of knowledge of the City's Building Department so as to provide uninterrupted service to

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all residences and businesses in the community; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
