

RESOLUTION NO. R-17-14

A RESOLUTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE POOL COMPLEX TO BE INSTALLED AT AVON MUNICIPAL AQUATIC FACILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Administration and City Council have been preparing for the development and construction of an aquatic facility in the center of town to be located behind the Post Office, Police and Fire Station complex; and

WHEREAS, the second phase of this construction project will consist of construction of the pool package to be installed at Avon Municipal Aquatic Facility, including but not limited to: 1) Competitive Swimming Pool with 50 meter length and diving well depth(s); 2) Recreational Swimming Pool with water slides and activity features. This pool shall also include a “zero-depth” area; 3) “Splash Pad” area with water features (fountains, play features, etc. - not intended to hold water; and 4) “Lazy River” component including a “zero-depth” area; and

WHEREAS, Council, after having reviewed the aquatic center site plans and discussing with the Administration the need to move forward with the second phase of the project, deems it in the best interests of the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Avon that the City move forward with advertising for bids for the construction of these improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Mayor is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of the pool package at the municipal aquatic facility to be located behind the Post Office, Police and Fire Station complex pursuant to plans and specifications prepared and submitted by the City Engineer and Sixmo, Inc. which are on file and open for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of Council.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to advertise for bids for the construction of the pool package at the municipal aquatic facility; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
