

RESOLUTION NO. R-18-14

**A RESOLUTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A
RIGHT TURN LANE, SOUTHBOUND ON STATE ROUTE 83
TO THE I-90 WESTBOUND ENTRANCE RAMP
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, due primarily to the large amount of southbound traffic on State Route 83 seeking to access the westbound entrance ramp onto Interstate 90, it is necessary for the City to install an additional travel lane dedicated to right turns; and

WHEREAS, this project involves the installation of a 400' long 11' wide dedicated right turn lane, southbound, on S.R. 83 from Chester Road to the I-90 WB entrance ramp and will include excavation and embankment, pavement removal, underdrain installation, asphalt paving, signage, pavement markings, traffic signal modifications, maintenance of traffic, and lawn restoration; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon and the motoring public in general that the City go forward with advertising for bids to complete the right turn lane on State Route 83, southbound onto the I-90 westbound ramp.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the installation of a 400' long 11' wide dedicated right turn lane, southbound, on S.R. 83 from Chester Road to the I-90 WB entrance ramp to include excavation and embankment, pavement removal, underdrain installation, asphalt paving, signage, pavement markings, traffic signal modifications, maintenance of traffic, and lawn restoration. These improvements shall be made pursuant to plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer and prepared by Bramhall Engineering & Surveying Company, Inc. which shall be on file and open for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of Council and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4- That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens

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of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to advertise for bids for the installation of a right turn lane on State Route 83, southbound onto the I-90 westbound ramp before the close of the 2014 construction season; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
