

RESOLUTION NO. R-21-14

A RESOLUTION TO RE-ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE POOL COMPLEX TO BE INSTALLED AT AVON MUNICIPAL AQUATIC FACILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council, pursuant to Resolution 17-14, passed on September 22, 2014, advertised for bids for the development and construction of an aquatic facility in the center of town to be located behind the Post Office, Police and Fire Station complex; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened on October 30, 2014, and the Administration, together with the City's Consulting Engineer, Sixmo, Inc., has rejected all the bids submitted; and

WHEREAS, Sixmo, along with the Administration, has re-designed certain portions of the project to reduce costs and gain efficiencies and now seeks to re-advertise for bids; and

WHEREAS, Council, in an effort to complete the improvements for this aquatic center in an economical fashion and within the earliest possible time-frame, deems it to be in the best interests of the safety, health and welfare of the Community, to re-advertise for bids to complete these improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to re-advertise for bids for the installation and construction of an aquatic facility in the center of town to be located behind the Post Office, Police and Fire Station complex pursuant to the revised plans and specifications prepared by Sixmo, Inc. and which are on file and open for inspection in the Office of the Clerk of Council.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to re-advertise for bids for the construction of an aquatic facility in the center of town to be located behind the Post Office, Police and Fire Station complex so as to complete the project in a cost efficient and timely manner; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
