

ORDINANCE NO. 16-13

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF
A PUBLIC STREET TO WIT: MIDDLE ROAD
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VII, Section 2(d) of the Charter of the City of Avon, the Planning Commission must approve the construction of any public street; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, on July 17, 2006, after holding a public hearing, voted to approve the construction of Middle Road by a vote of five (5) to zero (0); and

WHEREAS, Council has had the opportunity to review the final plat and the proposed dedication of this public street; and

WHEREAS, after said review and further consideration, Council believes that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon, to approve the final plat for Middle Avenue and to accept the dedication of same as public thoroughfares within the City of Avon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the final plat for Middle Road as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is accepted by Council and hereby dedicated as a public street bearing the name Middle Road.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to approve the final plat and dedication of Middle Road as public thoroughfare within the City of Avon; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
