

ORDINANCE NO. 46-13

**AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT §1244.110 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF AVON TO CLARIFY THE SIGNIFICANCE
OF FINAL PLAT APPROVAL**

WHEREAS, the Planning Coordinator, Asst. Fire Chief, City Engineer and Chief Building Official have recommended changes to the Planning and Zoning Code, viz., an amendment to Chapter 1244 to clarify the significance of “Final Plat Approval” by adding §1244.110 setting forth the limitations on said approval; and

WHEREAS, said amendments is designed to clearly inform the subdividers of property of their further responsibility to abide by all federal, state and local laws and regulations that may impact their development; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission authorized a Public Hearing on said amendments which was duly publicized according to law and held on March 20, 2013; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2013, by a vote of five (5) to zero (0), Planning Commission recommended approval of said amendment to Chapter 1244 of the Planning and Zoning Code; and

WHEREAS, Council, on April 8, 2013, authorized a Public Hearing; and

WHEREAS, said Public Hearing was duly publicized according to law and was held on May 13, 2013 at 7:25 PM; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that this recommendation is reasonable and in the best interests of the safety, health and welfare of the City; and deems it desirable that Chapter 1244 of the Codified Ordinances be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That Chapter 1244 shall be amended to **add** §1244.110 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Avon to state: (New language **in bold** print)

1244.110 SIGNIFICANCE OF FINAL PLAT APPROVAL.

Final plat approval does not absolve responsibility for compliance with the City's Building Codes, The Ohio Fire Codes, ADA requirements or any other governmental laws and regulations.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this

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Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3- That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force at the earliest date allowed by law.
