

ORDINANCE NO. 88-13

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE AVON LOCAL SCHOOL
DISTRICT FOR THE SERVICES OF A SCHOOL RESOURCE OFFICER
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Avon Police Department and the Avon Local School District have agreed upon the hiring of a School Resource Officer for the purpose of providing a positive police presence in the Avon City Schools; and

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Understanding has been created to outline the costs, duties and responsibilities of the School Resource Officer; and

WHEREAS, Council, having reviewed the Memorandum of Understanding, deems it desirable and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to authorize the Mayor to enter into said MOU with the Avon Local School District to facilitate the placement of a School Resource Officer in their facilities for the upcoming 2013-2014 school year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the City, through the office of the Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Avon Local School District, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, for the placement of a School Resource Officer at school facilities within the City of Avon for the school year 2013-2014.

Section 2 – That the total cost of hiring two (2) School Resource Officers for the start of the 2013-2014 School Year through December 31, 2013 is calculated to be Forty-Six Thousand, Two Hundred and Eighty-Five Dollars (\$46,285.00). The Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate these funds and make payment in said amount from the Police Fund No. 221.

Section 3 - That is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees which resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, Ohio, the immediate emergency being the necessity to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Avon Local School District for the utilization of a School Resource Officer at their facilities for the upcoming school year; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
