

ORDINANCE NO. 142-13

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 210.01(g) OF THE CODIFIED
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AVON TO ADD VARIOUS FLOODPLAIN PERMIT
FEES CONSISTENT WITH THOSE ADOPTED IN CHAPTER 1050
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Chapter 210 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Avon attempts to compile a complete listing of all fees and deposits required by various sections of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, Council recently modified certain fees contained in Chapter 1050 as they pertain to floodplain issues (see Ord. No. 141-13); and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed these fees together with the Finance Director and deems them to reasonable and appropriate; and

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed these amendments to Section 210.01(g) and finds that adoption of same are in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That Section 210.01(g) is hereby amended as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein by this reference. The City's codifier is hereby instructed to make the necessary changes to the existing Section 210.01(g) to reflect the amendments contained herein.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity of adopting amendments to Section 210.01(g) as they pertain to floodplain permitting fees; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
