

RESOLUTION NO. R-17-13

A RESOLUTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE 2013 ROAD PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, due primarily to normal wear and tear and increased traffic, it is necessary for the City to repair, re-pave, and improve certain roads/streets within the municipality during the upcoming construction season; and

WHEREAS, City officials have determined that the following roads will be improved or reconstructed at the following locations: State Route 83 (Mills Road to Rail Road Tracks – Avon/Avon Lake Border); Sandy Lane (Mapleridge Blvd. to Schwartz Rd.); Tullis Drive (Lear Nagel Road to end of Tullis Drive); Nagel Road (Northern I-90 Interchange Construction Limits to Railroad Tracks – Avon/Avon Lake border; and Alternate No. 1 -- Timberview Drive (Jaycox Road to end of Timberview Drive); and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Community that the City go forward with advertising for bids to complete the 2013 Road Program which includes the above referenced projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the City is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for road improvements at the following locations: State Route 83 (Mills Road to Rail Road Tracks – Avon/Avon Lake Border); Sandy Lane (Mapleridge Blvd. to Schwartz Rd.); Tullis Drive (Lear Nagel Road to end of Tullis Drive); Nagel Road (Northern I-90 Interchange Construction Limits to Railroad Tracks – Avon/Avon Lake border; and Alternate No. 1 - Timberview Drive (Jaycox Road to end of Timberview Drive). These improvements shall be made pursuant to plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer and prepared by Bramhall Engineering & Surveying Company, Inc. which shall be on file and open for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of Council and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4- That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to advertise for bids for the 2013 City of Avon Road Program prior to the beginning of construction season; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
