

RESOLUTION NO. R-24-13

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR STATE ISSUE ONE FUNDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO CHESTER ROAD AT STATE ROUTE 611 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, due to the results of a Safety Study conducted by the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT), the City is considering improvements to the intersection of State Route 611 and Chester Road; and

WHEREAS, the City, to address the issues raised in the ODOT Study, desires to improve the intersection of State Route 611 and Chester Road by relocating Chester Road to the west and aligning it with Recreation Lane; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that this improvement may be eligible for partial funding with Issue One (1) Funds from the State of Ohio, Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC); and

WHEREAS, this project will significantly further the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon and the motoring public by improving the intersection of State Route 611 and Chester Road by aligning Chester Road with Recreation Lane and thereby creating a smoother and safer flow of traffic on these major thoroughfares running through the City of Avon.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the City shall file an application for State Issue One (1) funds for the year 2013, Round 28, to obtain much needed financial assistance for public improvements within the City of Avon, to wit: The relocation of Chester Road to the west of its current location on the north side of State Route 611, together with all appurtenances thereto, so that it aligns with Recreation Lane on the south side of State Route 611.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3 - That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to obtain State Issue One funding to realign Chester Road with Recreation Lane at State Route 611; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
