

RESOLUTION NO. R-35-13

**A RESOLUTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE
CHESTER ROAD WIDENING PROJECT
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Chester Road/State Route 611 intersection improvements will necessitate detouring traffic from Moore Road to State Route 83; and

WHEREAS, this detour will result in larger, heavier vehicular traffic along this local thoroughfare; and

WHEREAS, the City hired Bramhall Engineering to prepare plans and specifications for the construction of improvements (widening) to Chester Road from Moore Road east to State Route 83 to facilitate this increased traffic; and

WHEREAS, Planning Commission, on December 11, 2013 by a vote of five (5) in favor and zero (0) opposed, approved the installation and construction of these improvements per said plans and specifications; and

WHEREAS, Council finds it to be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to go forward with advertising for bids to complete the Chester Road Widening Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for construction of public improvements to Chester Road, a.k.a. the Chester Road Widening Project. The project will consist of the following:

Base Bid: Pavement Widening of 6,330 L.F. of Chester Road. Pavement Widening will also entail the clearing of trees, storm sewer replacement, ditch enclosure, catch basin removal and replacement, fire hydrant relocation and replacement, full depth asphalt repairs, pavement milling and asphalt resurfacing, driveway rehabilitation, pavement markings, signage, maintaining traffic and restoration.

These improvements will be constructed pursuant to plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer and prepared by Bramhall Engineering which shall be on file and open for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of Council and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open

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meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4- That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to advertise for bids for the Chester Road Widening project; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
