

RESOLUTION NO. R-7-15

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE LORAIN
COUNTY TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FUND FOR THE
ENGINEERING OF A PORTION OF IMPROVEMENTS ON NAGEL ROAD
SOUTH OF I-90 AND NORTH OF DETROIT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Nagel Road, south of I-90 and north of Detroit Road, as a result of the opening of the Nagel Road/Interstate 90 Interchange and the expansion of the Cleveland Clinic Health Center, is in need of public improvements for the safety for vehicular and pedestrian traffic; and

WHEREAS, to obtain a portion of the funding for the engineering of this public improvement project, the City Engineer and Planning Coordinator are requesting that City Council pass this Resolution in Support of the Transportation Improvement District funding; and

WHEREAS, Council, finding that this improvement may be eligible for partial funding with monies from the Transportation Improvement District through the Lorain County Engineer's Office, expresses its full support for its installation; and

WHEREAS, Council finds it to be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to go forward with requesting funding for the engineering of this project; and

WHEREAS, Council, further finds that this project will significantly enhance the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon by improving the intersection of Nagel Road and Detroit Road and by widening and improving 1350 feet of roadway north of Detroit Road and make vehicular and pedestrian travel safer through this area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That Council hereby supports the filing of an application for Transportation Improvement District funds for the SFY16 period, to obtain much needed financial assistance for public improvements within the City of Avon, to wit: road improvements (repaving and widening) of 1350 feet of roadway south of I-90 and north of Detroit Road, signal upgrades, increased storage lengths and additional turn and through lanes at the Detroit Road/Nagel Road intersection along with a center two-way left turn lane, new sidewalks and all appurtenances thereto.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

Resolution No. R-7-15 (Con't)

Section 3 - That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to obtain Transportation Improvement District funds for the improvements to Nagel Road; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
