

ORDINANCE NO. 118-15

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE A DEVELOPER'S AGREEMENT
WITH JARONE DEVELOPMENT, LLC FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE
INTERSECTION OF NAGEL AND MIDDLETON ROADS
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Jarone Development, LLC is seeking to develop property it owns on Nagel Road between Avon Road and Detroit Road; and

WHEREAS, said development will require improvements to Nagel Road at the intersection of Nagel and Middleton; and

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2015, the Planning Commission voted to approve plans and specifications for the Nagel and Middleton Road intersection improvements by a vote of Five (5) to Zero (0); and

WHEREAS, Council has had the opportunity to review the Developer's Agreement with Jarone Development, LLC and has provided the Developer the opportunity to discuss the proposed Agreement along with the final plans and specifications for the construction of these specific improvements; and

WHEREAS, after discussion, review and further consideration, Council has deemed it acceptable, appropriate and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to enter into a written Developer's Agreement to provide for the construction of the improvements to the Nagel and Middleton road intersection as set forth in the plans and specifications approved by Planning Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the City of Avon is hereby authorized to enter into a Developer's Agreement with Jarone Development, LLC for the Nagel Road intersection improvements at Nagel and Middleton roads pursuant to plans and specifications approved by Planning Commission on July 29, 2015, and subsequently finalized by the City's Engineer. A copy of said Developer's Agreement is attached hereto and marked as "Exhibit A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - The Mayor and President of Council are hereby authorized to sign said Developer's Agreement on behalf of the City.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to authorize the City to enter into a Developer's Agreement with Jarone Development, LLC for the construction of improvements at the intersection of Nagel and Middleton roads; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
