

ORDINANCE NO. 122-15

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1444 OF THE CODIFIED
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AVON GOVERNING THE
REGISTRATION OF CONTRACTORS
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, to insure high standards of performance and workmanship in public and private construction, the City requires all contractors performing work within the City of Avon be registered with the City of Avon Building Department; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Building Official has reviewed the City's Contractor Registration ordinances and has recommended updating them to protect the interests of both public and private property owners; and

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed the proposed amendments to Chapter 1444 and finds that adoption of same to be in the best interests of the health, safety and general welfare of the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That Chapter 1444, as amended, is hereby adopted as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A", which is incorporated herein by the reference. The City's codifier is hereby instructed to remove the existing Chapter 1044 and replace it with the version set forth herein.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to adopt the revised sections of Chapter 1444 of the codified ordinances of the City of Avon as they pertain to contractor registration; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
