

ORDINANCE NO. 121-15

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 210.01(g) AND 1442.08(c) OF THE
CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AVON
REGARDING BUILDING PERMITS AND FEES
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City's Chief Building Official has reviewed Section 210.01(g) regarding "Building and Housing Code Permits and Fees" to update with current practices within the Building Department; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 210 of the Avon Codified Ordinances covers the City's General Fee Schedule and Section 210.01(g) specifically pertains to the Building and Housing Code; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Building Official, on behalf of the Administration, has requested a modification to the fee schedule for inspection fees contained in §210.01(g)(6)(C) and 1442.08(c) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Avon; and

WHEREAS, Council, having reviewed said amendments, finds them to be appropriate and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon and desires to amend Section 210.01(g), to insure consistency throughout the Code with changes being made to Chapter 1442.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That Section 210.01(g)(6)(C) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Avon which currently reads as follows:

- (g) Building and Housing Code
 - (6) Miscellaneous building permit and inspection fees (Sec. 1442.08).
 - C. When an inspection is required and made, and the work is found to be either incomplete or not in compliance with the applicable building code(s), or at variance with the approved plans and specifications, a charge for each reinspection required to verify compliance shall be made at the rate of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per inspection.

shall be amended to read as follows: (New language in bold print)

- (g) Building and Housing Code
 - (6) Miscellaneous building permit and inspection fees (Sec. 1442.08).
 - C. When an inspection is required and made, and the work is found to be either incomplete or not in compliance with the applicable building code(s), or at variance with the approved plans and specifications, a charge for each reinspection required to verify compliance shall be made at the rate of **one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00)** per inspection.

Section 2 - That Section 1442.08(c) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Avon which currently reads as follows:

1442.08 MISCELLANEOUS BUILDING PERMIT AND INSPECTION FEES.

(c) When an inspection is required and made, and the work is found to be either incomplete or not in compliance with the applicable building code(s), or at variance with the approved plans and specifications, a charge for each reinspection required to verify compliance shall be made at the rate of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per inspection.

shall be amended to read as follows: (New language in bold print)

1442.08 MISCELLANEOUS BUILDING PERMIT AND INSPECTION FEES.

(c) When an inspection is required and made, and the work is found to be either incomplete or not in compliance with the applicable building code(s), or at variance with the approved plans and specifications, a charge for each reinspection required to verify compliance shall be made at the rate of **one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00)** per inspection.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to amend Sections 210.01(g) and 1442.08(c) of the Avon Codified Ordinances to make them consistent with practices being utilized by the Building Department; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
