

ORDINANCE NO. 16-16

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT APPROPRIATIONS
ORDINANCE NO. 150-16 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, certain funds within the amount appropriated in Ordinance No. 150-15 do not meet the estimated operational expenses; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 150-15 be amended, supplemented and reappropriated as indicated on the attached Exhibit, which is made a part of this Ordinance by reference.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity and desirability of establishing a provision of funds for the expenditures for the fiscal year 2016 in order to maintain an efficient City operation; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor.

Special Revenue Funds

Park Development Fund (251)

Appropriate \$75,000.00 for dismantling of a barn where the proposed entrance/exit into Schwartz Road Park will be built, and for preliminary engineering expenses. This project will be funded with note proceeds from the September, 2015 Series 2015 Recreation Bond Anticipatory Notes.

Total Special Revenue Funds	\$75,000.00
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Capital Project Funds

Mills Road Water main Transmission Line (413)

Reduce appropriations (\$1,350,000.00) for the Series 2015 Bond Anticipatory Notes as the 2016 notes were renewed for this much less than originally budgeted.

Riegelsberger/Jaycox Road Bridge Fund (438)

Appropriate \$45,000.00 as an additional amount the City must pay toward the final pay application for this project. The OPWC Grant/Loan maximum amount of \$350,000.00 has been met.

Chester Road Re-Location Fund (475)

Increase appropriations \$75,000.00 for City share of project close-out and change order expenses.

Total Capital Project Funds Re-appropriations reduction	(\$1,230,000.00)
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Total Re-appropriations reduction all funds	(\$1,155,000.00)
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
