

ORDINANCE NO. 27-16

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT APPROPRIATIONS
ORDINANCE NO. 150-15 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, certain funds within the amount appropriated in Ordinance No. 150-15 do not meet the estimated operational expenses; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 150-15 be amended, supplemented and reappropriated as indicated on the attached Exhibit, which is made a part of this Ordinance by reference.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity and desirability of establishing a provision of funds for the expenditures for the fiscal year 2016 in order to maintain an efficient City operation; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor.

Ordinance No. 27-16

Special Revenue Funds

Stadium Highway Marquee Fund (284)

Appropriate \$80,000.00 for stadium improvements, specifically \$47,122.25 for game and bullpen “portable” mounds and artificial turf. We will be reimbursed \$33,333.34 from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources as part of the Capital Improvement Grant the City was awarded. The balance of the appropriation will be used for other improvements anticipated this year. The City recently received \$80,000.00 in the settlement with Avon Baseball LLC.

Total Special Revenue Funds	\$80,000.00
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Capital Project Funds

Parkland Acquisition Fund (408)

Appropriate \$3,469.84 for legal expenses associated with the purchase of the Creekside property.

Chester Road Widening Voluntary Assessment (Project K) Fund (426)

Appropriate \$600,000 for property acquisition needed for the 5-lane roadway. Appropriate \$600,000 for Columbia Gas for gas line re-location. Appropriate \$700,000.00 for other utility re-location expenses and preliminary engineering expenses. These funds are available from the Series 2016 Bond Anticipatory Note proceeds that were issued in January.
