

ORDINANCE NO. 45-16

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1073.03(b)(1) and (2) OF THE CODIFIED
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AVON REGARDING AVON ISLE
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Director of Parks have reviewed the rules, regulations and rental rates for the Avon Isle; and

WHEREAS, owing to the increase in expense to operate Avon Isle it was determined that the fees charged in §1073.03(b)(1) and (2) need to be increased; and

WHEREAS, Council having reviewed the proposed amendments, finds them to be appropriate and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon and should be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That Sections 1073.03(b)(1) and (2) which currently reads as follows:

(b) The following fees and deposits for use of Avon Isle shall be paid at the time of issuance of the required permit:

(1) Avon residents using the Center for a one-time only personal, for profit or a nonprofit function, fees shall be as follows:

<u>Hours</u>	<u>Fees</u>
2	\$150.00 (Minimum)
3	\$185.00
4	\$220.00
5	\$255.00
6	\$290.00
7 or more	\$35.00 for each additional hour

In addition, there shall be a two-hundred dollar (\$200.00) refundable deposit for damage and cleanup.

(2) Non-residents or individuals, businesses, organizations or groups using the Center for a one-time only personal, for-profit or a non-profit function, fee shall be as follows:

<u>Hours</u>	<u>Fees</u>
2	\$200.00 (Minimum)
3	\$250.00
4	\$300.00
5	\$350.00
6	\$400.00
7 or more	\$50.00 for each additional hour

In addition, there shall be a two-hundred fifty dollar (\$250.00) refundable deposit for damage and cleanup. (Ord. 134-12. Passed 12-10-12.)

shall be amended as follows: (new language in bold print)

(b) The following fees and deposits for use of Avon Isle shall be paid at the time of issuance of the required permit:

(1) Avon residents using the Center for a one-time only personal, for profit or a nonprofit function, fees shall be as follows:

<u>Hours</u>	<u>Fees</u>
2	\$150.00 (Minimum)
3	\$185.00 \$200.00
4	\$220.00 \$250.00
5	\$255.00 \$300.00
6	\$290.00 \$350.00
7 or more	\$35.00 \$50.00 for each additional hour

In addition, there shall be a two-hundred dollar (\$200.00) refundable deposit for damage and cleanup.

(2) Non-residents or individuals, businesses, organizations or groups using the Center for a one-time only personal, for-profit or a non-profit function, fee shall be as follows:

<u>Hours</u>	<u>Fees</u>
2	\$200.00 (Minimum)
3	\$250.00 \$275.00
4	\$300.00 \$350.00

5	\$350.00 \$425.00
6	\$400.00 \$500.00
7 or more	\$50.00 \$75.00 for each additional hour

In addition, there shall be a two-hundred fifty dollar (\$250.00) refundable deposit for damage and cleanup. (Ord. 134-12. Passed 12-10-12.)

Section 2 - The codifier is hereby instructed to insert the amendments into the Codified Ordinances of the City of Avon as set forth herein.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to amend §1073.03(b)(1)and(2) of the Avon Codified Ordinances to update the fees charged by the Avon Parks Department; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
