

ORDINANCE NO. 91-16

**AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD THE BID FOR THE
STATE ROUTE 83 (CENTER ROAD) PAVEMENT REPAIR PROJECT WITH ALL
APPURTENANCES THERETO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council, pursuant to Resolution R-19-16, passed on July 5, 2016, advertised for bids for the construction of public improvements along State Route 83 (Center Road), known as the State Route 83 (Center Road) Pavement Repair Project; and

WHEREAS, City officials have determined that Center Road will be improved where recommended by the City Engineer between State Route 254 (Detroit Road) and Mills Road. The project shall consist of partial and full depth asphalt pavement repairs at intermittent locations, asphalt pavement resurfacing of repair areas only, reinstallation of impacted pavement markings, maintenance of traffic, and associated restoration; and

WHEREAS, the public bids were opened and read aloud at noon on July 28, 2016 at Avon City Hall for the State Route 83 (Center Road) Pavement Repair Project. The bids received are as follows:

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Estimate for the project was \$190,000.00. As such the bid submitted by Specialized Construction is 21.6% below the Engineer's Estimate. A copy of the bid tabulation is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed each of the bids submitted and is recommending that the bid submitted by Specialized Construction be considered the lowest and best bid submitted for the State Route 83 (Center Road) Pavement Repair Project.

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Community that the City of Avon go forward with awarding a construction contract to complete the State Route 83 (Center Road) Pavement Repair Project as referenced above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - Pursuant to bids received on July 28, 2016 for the State Route 83 (Center Road) Pavement Repair Project, the bid submitted by Specialized Construction in the amount of

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One Hundred, Forty-Eight Thousand, Nine Hundred, Five Dollars and no Cents (\$148,905.00) is declared to be the lowest and best bid and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with that entity. In addition, the Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payment pursuant to said contract from the State Highway Fund No. 205. Further, the Finance Director is authorized to increase this appropriation by a reasonable amount for engineering and legal fees associated with this project.

Section 2- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3- That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to undertake and substantially complete the State Route 83 (Center Road) Pavement Repair Project prior to the end of the 2016 construction season; therefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
