

ORDINANCE NO. 127-16

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND '210.01 (e)(6A)(D) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF AVON TO ESTABLISH RATES FOR THE USE OF
THE CITY=S AQUATIC CENTER IN THE YEAR 2017
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Administration, particularly the Director of Parks and Recreation, has recommended that there be permit fees established for the use of the City=s Aquatic Center for 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee of Council has considered the proposed fees for the Aquatic facility and the appropriateness of amending Section 210.01(e)(6A)(D) and recommended to Council that said fees be adopted; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon the recommendation of the Finance Committee and after review of the proposed fees, deems it in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the community that these amendments establishing fees for the use of the City=s Aquatic Center in 2017 be adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That Section 210.01(e)(6A)(D) which currently reads as follows:

Section 2 - The codifier is hereby instructed to insert the amendments into the Codified Ordinances of the City of Avon as set forth herein.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to amend Section 210.01(e)(6A)(D) to establish fees for the use of the Aquatic Center in the City of Avon; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
