

RESOLUTION NO. R-2-17

A RESOLUTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE CANDLEWOOD DRIVE & WISTERIA WAY PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, due primarily to normal wear and tear, it is necessary for the City to repair, and improve both Candlewood Drive & Wisteria Way at certain locations within the municipality during the 2017 construction season; and

WHEREAS, City officials have determined that these roadways will be improved where recommended by the City Engineer in the following locations: Candlewood Drive, between Sandalwood Drive and Carleen Avenue along with approximately two hundred feet of Carleen Avenue at the intersection; and Wisteria Way, between State Route 254 (Detroit Road) and Lilac Lane; and

WHEREAS, the project shall consist of overtopping the existing concrete surface with an asphalt pavement via the grinding of the existing concrete surface, placement of a fiberglass paving mat and gravel chip seal layer and then overtopping with two courses of asphalt concrete pavements. Pavement and catch basin repairs will also be performed at intermittent locations along with reinstallation of impacted pavement markings, maintenance of traffic, and associated restoration; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Community that the City go forward with advertising for public bids to complete the Candlewood Drive & Wisteria Way Pavement Resurfacing Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for public bids for the completion of asphalt resurfacing at the locations determined by the City Engineer. These improvements shall be made pursuant to plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer and Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd. which shall be on file and open for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of Council and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4- That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to advertise for bids for the

Candlewood Drive & Wisteria Way Pavement Resurfacing Project in order to facilitate completion prior to the end of 2017 construction season; therefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
