

**ORDINANCE NO. 11-18**

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH COMPENSATION FOR THE POSITION  
OF RECREATION COORDINATOR FOR THE CITY OF AVON  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Council passed Ord. No. 9-18 at a Special Meeting of Council held on Tuesday, January 17, 2018 to adopt amendments to the Class Specification for Recreation Coordinator; and

**WHEREAS**, Council needs to establish a range of compensation for said position; and

**WHEREAS**, the Administration recommends that the starting pay for the Recreation Coordinator position for the year 2018 be set at between Sixty Thousand (\$60,000.00) and Seventy Five Thousand (\$75,000.00) Dollars; and

**WHEREAS**, Council, upon recommendation of the Administration, finds adoption of the compensation range proposed for the position of Recreation Coordinator to be reasonable, and adoption of same to be in the best interests of the health safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon in maintaining a well-qualified, efficient and productive Recreation Coordinator on the City staff.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That the Recreation Coordinator, upon being hired by the Mayor, shall receive an annual salary, to be determined by the Mayor, between the range of Sixty Thousand (\$60,000.00) and Seventy Five Thousand (\$75,000.00) Dollars, said amount to be prorated from the date of hire to the end of that fiscal year. In addition, said employee shall receive all other benefits of a full-time, non-bargaining unit employee.

Section 2 - That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds necessary to meet the compensation established for this position within the range set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity of establishing compensation for the Recreation Coordinator in order to maintain a well-qualified, efficient and productive City staff; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
