

ORDINANCE NO. 31-18

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH COMPENSATION FOR THE PART-TIME
UNCLASSIFIED RECREATION SUPERVISOR POSITION FOR THE CITY OF AVON
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council, pursuant to Ordinance No. 30-18, established the part-time, unclassified position of Recreation Supervisor in §256.04 of the Codified Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that the starting range of pay for this position be established at an hourly rate of between Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and Seventeen Dollars (\$17.00) per hour, together with all other benefits of a part-time, non-bargaining unit employee of the City commencing with the date of hire through termination; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon recommendation of the Administration, finds adoption of the compensation range being proposed for the part-time, unclassified position of Recreation Supervisor to be reasonable and in the best interests of the health safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon in maintaining well-qualified, efficient and productive workforce.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That effective with the date of hire following passage of this Ordinance, the part-time, unclassified position of Recreation Supervisor shall be paid an hourly rate of between Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and Seventeen Dollars (\$17.00) per hour as determined by the Mayor, together with all other benefits of a part-time, non-bargaining unit employee of the City commencing with the date of hire through termination.

Section 2 - That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds necessary to meet the compensation established for this position as set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity of establishing a range of compensation for the part-time, unclassified position of Recreation Supervisor thus enabling the Mayor to fill the position; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
