

ORDINANCE NO. 83-18

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT
WITH GREAT LAKES RECYCLING, INC. D/B/A SIMPLE RECYCLING
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, a representative of Great Lakes Recycling, Inc. d/b/a Simple Recycling appeared before City Council and presented information about beginning a program in Avon for residential "soft recycling" of small appliances and textiles; and

WHEREAS, Council, having had an opportunity to review the Agreement provided by Great Lakes Recycling, deems it desirable and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to authorize the Mayor to enter into said Agreement thereby facilitating the collection of soft recyclables for four years, beginning in 2019 through 2022 from all of the City's residences.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That the Mayor of the City of Avon is hereby authorized to enter into a four (4) year agreement with Great Lakes Recycling, Inc. d/b/a/ Simple Recycling for the residential collection and disposal of soft recyclables. (Exhibit A).

Section 2 - That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, authorized to execute such agreement and to take such action to execute such other documents and amendments thereto as may be deemed necessary once approved by the Law Director.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 – That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, Ohio, the immediate emergency being the necessity to enter into an Agreement with Great Lakes Recycling, Inc., d/b/a/ Simple Recycling to begin residential collection and disposal of small appliances and textiles thereby reducing the quantity of soft recyclables which are deposited in local landfills; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
