

ORDINANCE NO. 17-19

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT APPROPRIATIONS
ORDINANCE NO. 93-18 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, certain funds within the amount appropriated in Ordinance No. 93-18 do not meet the estimated operational expenses; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 93-18 be amended, supplemented and reappropriated as indicated on the attached Exhibit, which is made a part of this Ordinance by reference.

Section 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity and desirability of establishing a provision of funds for the expenditures for the fiscal year 2019 in order to maintain an efficient City operation; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by this Council and approval by the Mayor.

Special Revenue Funds

Street Department Fund No. 201

Appropriate \$36,000.00 for a fabricated building, 5,400 square feet, to be used primarily for salt storage. The structure will be located on the Schneider Court property.

Mayors' Court Computer Fund No. 225

Appropriate \$30,000.00 for new court software. This software will be much more efficient and easier to use.

Total Special Revenue Funds Re-appropriations	\$66,000.00
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Capital Project Funds

Capital improvements Fund No. 401

Appropriate and transfer \$75,000.00 to the Veterans Memorial Project Fund No. 487 to ensure enough funds to complete the entire project.

2018 Road Program Fund No. 407

Appropriate \$5,000.00 for project closing expenses associated with the Applewood, Candlewood, etc. re-surfacing project performed in 2018.

Recreation Lane Improvements Fund No. 451

Appropriate \$12,000.00 to be used toward the final payment of \$18,020.50 for Freeman Building Systems, the General Contractor for T3, to complete the City's commitment as per Ordinance No. 83-16.

SR 83 – Mills Road Round-a-bout Project Fund No. 482

Appropriate \$10,000.00 for final amount due to the City of North Ridgeville for Avon's share of the cost of the project.

Total Capital Project Funds Re-appropriations	\$102,000.00
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Total Re-appropriations all funds	\$168,000.00
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
