

ORDINANCE NO. 82-19

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 210(e)(7A) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES
OF THE CITY OF AVON TO INCREASE A CERTAIN TRAINING
FEE TO BE CHARGED BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City's Fire Chief has requested a modification to the fee schedule for certain training provided by the City of Avon Fire Department Personnel which are contained in Section 210(e)(7A) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Avon; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Director reviewed the proposed amendment and has determined that the current fee schedule is in need of adjustment and recommends these changes to Council; and

WHEREAS, Council finds the recommendation of the Fire Chief and the Finance Director to be in the public interest and that the increase in said fee will result in additional revenues without any decrease in the level of service to citizens and will thereby promote the public health, safety, and welfare of the all residents of Avon.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That Section 210.01(e)(7A) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Avon which currently reads as follows:

shall be amended to read as follows: (New language in bold print)

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to amend Section 210.01(e)(7A) to amend fees for CPR/AED training for the citizens of the City of Avon and surrounding communities; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
