

ORDINANCE NO. 87-19

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR THE
PERMANENT, PART-TIME, UNCLASSIFIED POSITION
OF CITY TREASURER IN THE CITY OF AVON
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Council passed Ordinance No. 12-12 on March 5, 2012 establishing compensation for the permanent, part-time City Treasurer; and

WHEREAS, the Administration having reviewed Ordinance No. 12-12 for the permanent, part-time position of City Treasurer recommends that the language contained therein be revised for clarification purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that the starting pay for this position shall remain the same as established in Ordinance No. 106-18 which passed on December 26, 2018 and shall be paid as an annual salary of Eighteen Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Nine and 59/100 Dollars (\$18,559.59), payable bi-weekly, together with all other benefits of a permanent, part-time employee of the City commencing with the date of hire through termination; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon recommendation of the Administration, finds adoption of the compensation being proposed for the permanent, part-time, unclassified position of City Treasurer to be reasonable and in the best interests of the health safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon in maintaining well-qualified, efficient and productive workforce.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That effective with the date of hire following passage of this Ordinance or until otherwise revised by subsequent legislation, the permanent, part-time, unclassified position of City Treasurer shall be paid an annual salary of Eighteen Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Nine and 59/100 Dollars (\$18,559.59), payable bi-weekly and prorated from the date of hire. In addition, said employee shall receive all other benefits of a permanent, part-time, unclassified, non-bargaining unit employee.

Section 2 - That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds, if necessary, to meet the compensation established for this position as set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to clarify language pertaining to

compensation for the permanent, part-time, unclassified position of City Treasurer thus enabling the Mayor to fill the position; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
