

ORDINANCE NO. 96-19

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 1073 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF
THE CITY OF AVON TO INCREASE FEES FOR THE USE OF AVON ISLE,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Recreation Coordinator have reviewed the rules, regulations and rental rates for the Avon Isle; and

WHEREAS, owing to the elimination of the Director of Parks and the increase in expense to operate the facility it was determined that Chapter 1073 should be amended to address these issues; and

WHEREAS, Council as a whole, having reviewed said amendments, also finds them to be appropriate and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon and desires to amend Chapter 1073 as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That the provisions of Chapter 1073 pertaining to Parks shall be amended to read as set forth in the new Chapter 1073 attached to this Ordinance as Exhibit A which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - The Codifier is hereby instructed to insert the amendments into Chapter 1073 as contained in this legislation. All other language contained in Chapter 1073 not specifically amended herein shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to amend Chapter 1073 to update language contained therein and provide for increases in fees for Avon Isle; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
