

ORDINANCE NO. 125-19

**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH COMPENSATION FOR THE
FULL-TIME, UNCLASSIFIED POSITION OF DIRECTOR OF
PUBLIC SAFETY FOR THE CITY OF AVON
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 124-19, Council amended Section 256.04 and Section 256.98 of the Codified Ordinances to create a full-time, unclassified position of Director of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, Council must set compensation for said position; and

WHEREAS, the Administration recommends that the prorata annual salary for this full-time unclassified position be in a range of between One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00) and One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$140,000.00), in addition, to all other benefits of a full-time employee as set forth in Avon Codified Ordinances Chapter 256, commencing with the date of hire through termination; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon recommendation of the Administration, finds adoption of the compensation being proposed for the full-time, unclassified position of Director of Public Safety to be reasonable and in the best interests of the health safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon in maintaining well-qualified, efficient and productive staff for the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That effective with the date of hire following passage of this Ordinance, the full-time, unclassified position of Director of Public Safety shall be paid a prorata annual salary between One Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$110,000.00) and One Hundred Forty Thousand Dollars (\$140,000.00), in addition, to all other benefits of a full-time employee of the City, commencing with the date of hire through termination.

Section 2 - That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds necessary to meet the compensation established for this position as set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity of establishing the range of compensation for the full-time, unclassified position of Director of Public Safety thus enabling the Mayor to fill the position; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
