

ORDINANCE NO. 20-20

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 836.03(b)(3) OF THE CODIFIED
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AVON AS IT
PERTAINS TO PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS, AND CANVASSERS
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Chapter 836 provides for administrative procedures for the regulation of peddlers, solicitors and canvassers in the City of Avon; and

WHEREAS, the Administration, particularly, the Finance Department for the City of Avon, after reviewing this section of the Business Regulation and Taxation Code determined that an amendment to this section is in order; and

WHEREAS, Council, considering the recommendation of the Finance Department, finds that the proposed amendment to Chapter 836 to be reasonable and that adoption of same to be in the best interests of the safety, health and welfare of the citizens of Avon.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That Section 836.03(b)(3), which presently reads as follows:

**836.03 PEDDLING OR SOLICITING ON PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY;
 PERMIT REQUIRED; PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES; CANVASSING.**

(b) Application; Fee: Permit; Registration.

(3) Any permit issued under this chapter shall be valid for not more than 90 days.

Shall be amended to read as follows: (new language in bold print)

**836.03 PEDDLING OR SOLICITING ON PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY;
 PERMIT REQUIRED; PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES; CANVASSING.**

(b) Application; Fee: Permit; Registration.

(3) Any permit issued under this chapter shall be valid for not more than ~~90 days~~
six (6) months.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to amend Section 836.04(b)(3) of the Avon Codified Ordinances to increase the length of time during which a permit is valid; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
