

ORDINANCE NO. 34-20

AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD THE BID FOR THE DOOVYS STREET, JULIA AVENUE AND MIRIAM AVENUE PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, due primarily to normal wear and tear and increased traffic, it is necessary for the City to repair, and improve the pavement surface at certain locations identified by the Avon Street Superintendent and the City Engineer along Doovys Street, Julia Avenue and Miriam Avenue during the 2020 construction season; and

WHEREAS, Avon City Council passed Resolution R-5-20 on February 24, 2020 to advertise for bids for the Doovys Street, Julia Avenue and Miriam Avenue Road Pavement Resurfacing Project; and

WHEREAS, Avon City Council also requested via discussion at the February 24, 2020 Council Meeting that the public bid include securing a bid alternate for the resurfacing of Old Colorado Ave. north of Eaton Drive; and

WHEREAS, said project shall include the following: removal of the top portion of the existing pavement surface, full and partial depth pavement repairs at locations determined by the City Engineer, asphalt pavement surfacing, reinstallation of impacted pavement markings, maintenance of traffic, appurtenances thereto and associated restoration; and

WHEREAS, the public bids were opened and read aloud at noon on March 19, 2020 at the Avon Isle Community Center and the following bids were received:

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Estimated cost for the project base bid was set at \$344,215.00. As such, the bid submitted by Karvo Companies is 5.3% less than the Engineer's Estimate. A copy of the bid tabulation is attached hereto within Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Karvo Companies also responded to the Old Colorado Avenue Bid Alternate and presented a cost of \$31,739.25. All bid alternate responses received are also included in the bid tabulation attached hereto within Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed each of the bids submitted and is recommending that the bid submitted by Karvo Companies be considered the lowest and best bid for the Doovys Street, Julia Avenue and Miriam Avenue Road Pavement Resurfacing Project, a bid review memorandum is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Community that the City go forward with awarding the construction contract base bid submitted by the Karvo Companies for the Doovys Street, Julia Avenue and Miriam Avenue Road Pavement Resurfacing Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That pursuant to bids received on March 19, 2020 at the Avon Isle Community Center for the Doovys Street, Julia Avenue and Miriam Avenue Road Pavement Resurfacing Project, the base bid submitted by Karvo Companies in the amount of Three Hundred Twenty Five Thousand Eight Hundred Fifty Eight Dollars and 00/100 Cents (\$325,858.00) for the Doovys Street, Julia Avenue and Miriam Avenue Road Pavement Resurfacing Project is declared to be the lowest and best bid and the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with that entity. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payment from the 2020 Road Program Fund No. 410. If necessary, the Finance Director is further authorized to transfer sufficient funds from the General Fund No. 101 to the 2020 Road Program Fund No. 410. In addition, the Finance Director is authorized to increase this appropriation by a reasonable amount for engineering and legal fees associated with this project.

Section 2- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3- That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to undertake and substantially complete the Doovys Street, Julia Avenue and Miriam Avenue Road Pavement Resurfacing Project prior to the end of the 2020 construction season; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
