

ORDINANCE NO. 48-20

**AN ORDINANCE TO REJECT THE BID FOR THE FRENCH CREEK ROAD
PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROJECT
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Avon City Council passed Resolution R-7-20 on February 24, 2020 which authorized the public bid of the French Creek Road Pavement Resurfacing Project; and

WHEREAS, the project was to consist of the following: Removal of the top portion of the existing pavement surface, full and partial depth pavement repairs at locations determined by the City Engineer, asphalt pavement surfacing, reinstallation of impacted pavement markings, maintenance of traffic, appurtenances thereto and associated restoration; and

WHEREAS, the public bids were opened and read aloud at noon on March 19, 2020 at the Avon Isle Community Center and the following bids were received:

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Estimated cost for the project base bid was \$1,405,045.00. As such, the bid submitted by Karvo Companies is 23.6% less than the Engineer's Estimate. A copy of the bid tabulation is attached hereto within Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer reviewed each of the bids submitted and was recommending that the bid submitted by Karvo Companies be considered the lowest and best bid for the French Creek Road Pavement Resurfacing Project, a bid review memorandum is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration, together with City Council, reassessed the expenditure of funds for certain infrastructure projects in light of the COVID-19 global pandemic and decided not to proceed with a resurfacing project on French Creek Road to the extent depicted in the bid submitted but rather break the project up into two phases completed over multiple years.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDANIED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:**

Section 1 - That the public bids for the French Creek Road Pavement Resurfacing Project received on March 19, 2020 at the Avon Isle Community Center are hereby rejected by Avon City Council. The City Administration has reassessed the expenditure of funds for certain infrastructure projects in light of the COVID-19 global pandemic and has determined not to

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proceed with a resurfacing project on French Creek Road to the extent depicted in the bid submitted but rather perform the project in two phases over multiple years.

Section 2- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3- That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to reject the current bid for the French Creek Road Pavement Resurfacing Project due to its scope; therefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
