

ORDINANCE NO. 70-20

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A RANGE OF COMPENSATION FOR THE FULL-TIME, UNCLASSIFIED POSITION OF SUPERINTENDENT OF STREETS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 102-12, which passed on August 13, 2012, Council established compensation for the full-time, unclassified position of Superintendent of Streets; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has reviewed that compensation and now desires to establish a range of pay for the Superintendent of Streets position of between Eighty One Thousand and 00/100 (\$81,000.00) and One Hundred Nine Thousand, Five Hundred and 00/100, (\$109,500.00) Dollars, and

WHEREAS, Council, in agreement with the recommendation of the Administration, finds adoption of the new compensation range being proposed for the full-time, unclassified position of Superintendent of Streets to be reasonable, and adoption of same to be in the best interests of the citizens of Avon in maintaining well-qualified, efficient and productive staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 – That upon passage of this legislation, the range of compensation for the position of Superintendent of Streets shall be between Eighty One Thousand and 00/100 (\$81,000.00) and One Hundred Nine Thousand, Five Hundred and 00/100, (\$109,500.00) Dollars. All other aspects of the compensation package for this employee shall remain unchanged, i.e., said employee shall continue to receive all other benefits of a full-time, unclassified employee.

Section 2 – That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds necessary to meet the compensation established for this position within the range set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3 – That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 – That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to establish a range of compensation for the full-time, unclassified position of Superintendent of Streets; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
