

ORDINANCE NO. 76-20

**AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD THE BID FOR THE 2020 AVON
PAVEMENT MARKING PROGRAM
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, due primarily to normal wear and tear and increased traffic, it is necessary for the City to re-apply pavement markings on certain roads/streets within the municipality during the 2020 construction season; and

WHEREAS, Avon City Council passed Resolution R-17-20 on July 13, 2020 which authorized the public bid for said project known as the 2020 Avon Pavement Marking Program; and

WHEREAS, City officials have determined that the pavement markings on public roadways throughout the City will be re-applied, except where recent project pavement marking installations are still in good condition, pursuant to plans and specifications developed by the City Engineer and Chagrin Valley Engineering, Ltd. which shall be on file open for inspection at the Office of the Clerk of Council and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the public bids were opened and read aloud at noon on July 31, 2020 at Avon City Hall. The bids received for the 2020 Avon Pavement Marking Program are as follows:

Company	Bid
Dura Mark, Inc.	\$186,819.16
A & A Safety, Inc.	\$225,718.00

WHEREAS, the Engineer's Estimate for the project was \$204,741.00. The low bidder's base bid was 8.7% below that amount. A copy of the bid tabulation is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has reviewed each of the bids submitted and is recommending that the bid submitted by Dura Mark, Inc. be considered the lowest and best bid for the 2020 Avon Pavement Marking Program, a bid review memorandum is attached hereto as part of Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Community that the City Administration go forward with the awarding of a construction contract based on the public base bid submitted by Dura Mark, Inc. for the 2020 Avon Pavement Marking Program which was received on July 31, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 – That pursuant to bids received on July 31, 2020 at City Hall for the 2020 Avon Pavement Marking Program, the bid submitted by Dura Mark, Inc. in the amount of One Hundred

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Eighty Six Thousand Eight Hundred Nineteen Dollars and 16/100 Cents (\$186,819.16) for the 2020 Avon Pavement Marking Program is declared to be the lowest and best bid. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with that entity. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payment in said amount from the Street Construction and Maintenance Fund No. 201 and the State Highway Fund No. 205. In addition, the Finance Director is authorized to increase this appropriation by a reasonable amount for engineering and legal fees associated with this project.

Section 2 – That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 – That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to undertake and substantially complete the 2020 Avon Pavement Marking Program prior to the end of the 2020 construction season; therefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
