

ORDINANCE NO. 104-20

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 256.98 OF THE CODIFIED
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF AVON TO ADOPT A NEW
CLASSIFICATION SPECIFICATION FOR THE EXISTING POSITION
OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY TECHNICIAN-IN-TRAINING
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Avon has adopted an Administrative Code setting forth all the Classified and Unclassified positions of employment within the City together with classification specifications for each position; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2015, Council passed Ordinance No. 30-15 which created the full-time classified position of Information Technology Technician-in-Training; and

WHEREAS, the Administration, by and through the Finance Director, deems it desirable that the classification specification for Information Technology Technician-in-Training, as set forth in Section 256.98 of the Administrative Code, be amended to more accurately reflect the duties of the position; and

WHEREAS, after review of the amended classification specification for the Information Technology Technician-in-Training, Council deems it in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Avon that the amendment be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the classification specification set forth in Section 256.98 of the Codified Ordinances for the position of Information Technology Technician-in-Training is hereby amended as set forth in the attached Exhibit A which is incorporated herein by reference;

Section 2 - The Codifier is hereby instructed to replace the existing classification specification for Information Technology Technician-in-Training with the new classification specification into Section 256.98 of the Administrative Code.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being to adopt a new classification specification for the existing full-time, classified position of Information Technology Technician-in-Training; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
