

ORDINANCE NO. 5-21

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE LORAIN COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS AND THE CITY OF AVON TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LORAIN
COUNTY WENS EMERGENCY NOTIFICATIONS SYSTEM
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Lorain County Commissioners sets forth a goal of co-operative efforts with various political subdivisions of Lorain County to implement an Emergency Notification System; and

WHEREAS, the Lorain County Commissioners desire to enter into a contract with Inspiron Logistics for the same; and is also incurring the cost of installation, but there will be costs to any political subdivision that wishes to participate; and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Administration, Council finds it to be in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to enter into the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Lorain County Commissioners to participate in the Lorain County WENS Emergency Notifications System; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the City, through the office of the Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Lorain County Commissioners, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, allowing the City of Avon to participate in the WENS Emergency Notification System commencing in 2021 and ending in 2023.

Section 2 - That is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees which resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, Ohio, the immediate emergency being the necessity to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the Lorain County Commissioners to participate in the WENS Emergency Notification System for the period of 2021 – 2023; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
