

**ORDINANCE NO. 41-21**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AWARD A BID FOR THE JAYCOX  
ROAD–NORTH PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROJECT  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, due primarily to normal wear and tear and increased traffic, it is necessary for the City to repair, and improve the pavement surface at certain locations identified by the Avon Street Superintendent and the City Engineer along Jaycox Road north of Chester Road during the 2021 construction season; and

**WHEREAS**, Avon City Council passed Resolution R-6-21 on April 19, 2021 which authorized the public bid of said project known as the Jaycox Road-North Pavement Resurfacing Project; and

**WHEREAS**, said project shall consist of the following: Removal of the top portion of the existing asphalt surface, partial and full depth asphalt pavement repairs at locations determined by the City Engineer, asphalt pavement surfacing, reinstallation of impacted pavement markings, maintenance of traffic, appurtenances thereto and associated restoration; and

**WHEREAS**, the public bids were opened and read aloud at noon on May 13, 2021 at the Avon City Hall and the following bids were received:

**WHEREAS**, the Engineer's Estimated cost for the project was set at \$557,940.00. As such, the bid submitted by Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. is approximately 21.5% less than the Engineer's Estimate. A copy of the bid tabulation is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Engineer has reviewed each of the bids submitted and is recommending that the bid submitted by Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. be considered the lowest and best bid for the Jaycox Road-North Pavement Resurfacing Project. A bid review memorandum is attached hereto and incorporated herein as part of Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, Council finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the Community that the City go forward with the following: awarding of a construction contract based on the public bid submitted by the Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc. for the Jaycox Road-North Pavement Resurfacing Project, which was received on May 13, 2021.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:**

Section 1 – That pursuant to bids received on May 13, 2021 at Avon City Hall for the Jaycox Road-North Pavement Resurfacing Project, the bid submitted by Chagrin Valley Paving, Inc., (no relation to Chagrin Valley Engineering), in the amount of Four Hundred Thirty Seven Thousand Five Hundred Fifty One and 00/100 Cents (\$437,551.00) for the Jaycox Road-North Pavement Resurfacing Project is declared to be the lowest and best bid. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a construction contract with that entity. The Finance Director is hereby authorized to make payment in said amount from the 2021 Road Program Fund No. 419. If necessary, the Finance Director is further authorized to transfer sufficient funds from the General Fund No. 101 to the 2021 Road Program Fund No. 419 to meet the obligations of this contract. In addition, the Finance Director is authorized to increase this appropriation by a reasonable amount for engineering and legal fees associated with this project.

Section 2 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to undertake and substantially complete the Jaycox Road-North Pavement Resurfacing Project prior to the end of the 2021 construction season; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
