

ORDINANCE NO. 64-21

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE A DEVELOPER'S AGREEMENT WITH
MERIDIAN CONSTRUCTION & DESIGN, INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF
PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AT 31880 MILLS ROAD
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Meridian Construction & Design, Inc. is seeking to develop property it owns on Mills Road in the City of Avon; and

WHEREAS, said development will require the installation and dedication of a storm sewer extension within the City's right of way at 31880 Mills Road; and

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2021, the Planning Commission voted to recommend approval of extending and enclosing the storm sewer the width of the property located at 31880 Mills Road, by a vote of Five (5) to Zero (0); and

WHEREAS, Council has had the opportunity to review the Developer's Agreement with Meridian Construction & Design, Inc. and has provided the Developer the opportunity to discuss the proposed Developer Agreement and plans for the extension of the storm sewer; and

WHEREAS, after discussion, review and further consideration, Council has deemed it acceptable, appropriate and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the community to enter into a written Developer's Agreement to provide for the construction of the public improvements set forth therein

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:**

Section 1 - That the City of Avon hereby enters into a Developer Agreement with Meridian Construction & Design, Inc. for the extension of a storm sewer at 31880 Mills Road, a copy of said Agreement being attached hereto and marked Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - The Mayor and President of Council are hereby authorized to sign said Developer Agreement on behalf of the City.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to authorize a Developer's Agreement with Meridian Construction & Design, Inc. for the extension of a storm sewer and to enable completion

within the current construction period; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
