

ORDINANCE NO. 65-22

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH TYLER TECHNOLOGIES AND THE LORAIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF UPDATED COMPUTER AIDED DISPATCH (CAD), RECORDS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (RMS), MOBILE COMPUTING PLATFORM (MCP) AND ALL RELATED SOFTWARE AND HARDWARE FOR USE BY THE COUNTY 9-1-1- SYSTEM, AND TO EXECUTE A CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION EXCHANGE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE LORAIN COUNTY 9-1-1 AGENCY AND THE AVON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Lorain County is entering into an Agreement with Tyler Technologies to install updated Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD), Record Management System (RMS), Mobile Computing Platform (MCP) and all software and hardware for use by the County 9-1-1 in order to better accommodate services for those Users who access the County 9-1-1 system for emergency calls; and

WHEREAS, Lorain County is incurring the cost of installation of Tyler Technologies software solution, but there will be continuing maintenance costs to be shared by Users; and

WHEREAS, Users (Avon) intend to participate in and access the system through the County 9-1-1 system which will assist Users through data transmission to coordinate dispatching and the delivery of emergency services; and

WHEREAS, each Department participating in the MOU is responsible for their own data migration; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide continuity and stability, as well as to justify the expense necessary for installation of the new software, the County needs assurance of User's commitment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Avon desires to continue their relationship with the County to access Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD), Records Management System (RMS), and Mobile Computing Platform, used by the County 9-1-1 system; and

WHEREAS, to establish a policy detailing how Criminal Justice Information will be disseminated between the Lorain County 9-1-1 Agency and a Law Enforcement Agency/Fire Department, the Lorain County 9-1-1 is required to enter into a Criminal Justice Information Exchange Agreement (IEA) with the City of Avon Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, Council, after hearing from members of the Administration, particularly the City's Fire Chief, deems it desirable and in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon to authorize the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into said Memorandum thereby facilitating the use of the CAD/RMS/MCP and to enter into the Criminal Justice Information Exchange Agreement (IEA) for the dissemination of information from the Lorain County 9-1-1 Agency to the Avon Fire Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That the City, through the office of the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Lorain County Commissioners, a copy of which is attached hereto incorporated herein by reference as [Exhibit A](#), to share their CAD/RMS/MCP Systems with the Avon Fire Department.

Section 2 – That the City, through the office of the Mayor, or his designee, is further authorized to execute a Criminal Justice Information Exchange Agreement (IEA) between Lorain County 9-1-1 Agency and the Avon Fire Department to facilitate the dissemination of information from the Lorain County 9-1-1 Agency to the Avon Fire Department, a copy of which is attached hereto incorporated herein by reference as [Exhibit B](#).

Section 3 - That is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees which resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, Ohio, the immediate emergency being the necessity to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Lorain County Commissioners for the sharing of their CAD/RMS/MCP Systems with the Avon Fire Department, and to execute the Criminal Justice Information Exchange Agreement (IEA) between Lorain County 9-1-1 Agency and the Avon Fire Department to facilitate the dissemination of information from the Lorain County 9-1-1 Agency to the Avon Fire Department; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
