

ORDINANCE NO. 90-22

**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING PARK LANDS LOCATED ON THE
FORMER KURTZ BROTHERS NURSERY AS EAGLE POINT PARK
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Avon has acquired 16.64 acres of land from the Kurtz Brothers Nursery located at 39115 Detroit Road for use as a public park; and

WHEREAS, the Recreation Coordinator conducted a survey of the residents in an effort to choose an appropriate name and at the Regular Meeting of Council on February 28, 2022, Eagle Point Park was announced as the name selected; and

WHEREAS, Council now desires to officially name the park Eagle Point Park and finds that doing so is in the best interests of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1 - That the lands acquired by the City for park purposes located at 39115 Detroit Road formerly known as the Kurtz Brothers Nursery property, as set forth in the attached [Exhibit A](#) incorporated herein by reference, is hereby designated and officially named as Eagle Point Park,

Section 2 - That all references to this park land, including, but not limited to, maps and all other official documents, shall bear the designation, identification and name of Eagle Point Park. The Codifier shall insert this designation into the Avon Codified Ordinances as Section 1064.06.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to officially declare and name the property referenced herein as Eagle Point Park; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
