

ORDINANCE NO. 100-22

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO
A MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL AGREEMENT FOR THE NORTHEAST
LORAIN COUNTY TACTICAL RESPONSE TEAM COMPRISED OF THE CITY OF
AVON, CITY OF AVON LAKE AND CITY OF NORTH RIDGEVILLE
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Avon along with the City of Avon Lake and the City of North Ridgeville desire to jointly maintain and operate a multi-jurisdictional tactical response team to effectively respond to serious criminal occurrences; and

WHEREAS, maintenance and operation of such a team will require a multi-jurisdictional agreement which agreements are authorized pursuant to Sections 737.04, and 737.041 of the Ohio Revised Code and under the Lorain County, Ohio Amended Mutual Aid Agreement for Law Enforcement (See, Ordinance No. 37-21); and

WHEREAS, the Chiefs of Police for Avon, Avon Lake and North Ridgeville have created a multi-jurisdictional agreement to jointly maintain and operate a tactical response team and seek Council's authorization to enter into said agreement; and

WHEREAS, Council, after reviewing the proposed agreement, finds it necessary and desirable to enter into the Multi-jurisdictional Agreement for Northeast Lorain County Tactical Response Team providing for the interchange and use of personnel and equipment of member departments to further the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of each community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That Council hereby approves, accepts and authorizes the Mayor, or the Chief of Police as his designee, to enter into the Multi-jurisdictional Agreement for Northeast Lorain County Tactical Response Team with the cities of Avon Lake and North Ridgeville to provide mutual police aid and assistance through the interchange and use of personnel and equipment of each members' respective department, a copy of said contract being attached hereto, marked as "[Exhibit A](#)," and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2 - That is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees which resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, Ohio, the immediate emergency being the necessity to enter into the Multi-jurisdictional Agreement for the Northeast Lorain County Tactical Response Team in a timely manner to provide mutual police assistance in the interchange and use of personnel and equipment;

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therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
