

RESOLUTION NO. R-27-22

**A RESOLUTION TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE AVON POLICE
DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE AND INSTALL NEW DISPATCH CONSOLES
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the Administration, together with the Avon Police Department, has determined that it is necessary to advertise for bids to purchase and install new dispatch consoles to be used at the Avon Police Department located at 36145 Detroit Road in the City of Avon; and

WHEREAS, Council, having reviewed the request, deems it in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon that the City move forward with advertising for bids for this much needed equipment which will enhance the level of performance by our police dispatchers.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
AVON, COUNTY OF LORAIN AND STATE OF OHIO:**

Section 1 - That the Avon Police Department is hereby authorized to advertise for bids for the purchase and installation of new dispatch consoles pursuant to the plans and specifications on file with the City Safety Director.

Section 2 - That the City shall reserve the right to reject any and all bids.

Section 3- That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council of the City of Avon concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Council of the City of Avon and that all deliberations of this City's Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity to advertise for bids for purchase and installation of new dispatch consoles for the Avon Police Department; therefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
