

ORDINANCE NO. 118-22

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE RANGE OF COMPENSATION FOR THE
CLASSIFIED, FULL-TIME POSITION OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY
TECHNICIAN-IN-TRAINING FOR THE CITY OF AVON
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 35-15, which passed on March 23, 2015, Council established the range of compensation for the full-time, classified position of Information Technology Technician-In-Training; and

WHEREAS, the Administration has reviewed the pay range and now recommends an amendment to the range of pay for the Information Technology Technician-In-Training position to between Fourteen and 42/100 Dollars (\$14.42) per hour and Twenty-One and 63/100 Dollars (\$21.63) per hour; and,

WHEREAS, Council, in agreement with the recommendation of the Administration, finds the new compensation range being proposed for the position of Information Technology Technician-In-Training to be reasonable and adoption of same to be in the best interests of the health safety and welfare of the citizens of Avon in maintaining well-qualified, efficient and productive personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1 - That upon passage of this legislation, the range of compensation for the position of Information Technology Technician-In-Training shall be between Fourteen and 42/100 Dollars (\$14.42) per hour and Twenty-One and 63/100 Dollars (\$21.63) per hour. All other aspects of the compensation package for this employee shall remain unchanged, i.e., said employee shall continue to receive all other benefits of a full-time, classified employee.

Section 2 - That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate funds necessary to meet the compensation established for this position as set forth in Section 1, above.

Section 3 - That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4 - That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the necessity of amending the range of compensation for the full-time, classified position of Information Technology Technician-In-Training; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
